Request:

Edison Community College requests approval to offer an associate level program leading to the Ohio Prekindergarten Associate License.

Profile:

Edison Community College is a public community college that was founded in 1973. The community college has a specific mission to provide the learning opportunities, support services and commitment that enable students to complete their educational goals and realize their dreams. Located in Piqua, Ohio, the community college has an enrollment of over 4,500 students.

Accreditation/Authorization:

Edison Community College is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) until its next scheduled review in 2023.

Background:

Edison Community College is submitting its request to ensure program alignment with Ohio standards and requirements. Programs leading to the Prekindergarten Associate License are valid for teaching students in prekindergarten. Edison Community College offers the program leading to the Prekindergarten Associate License at the associate level.

Recommendation:

Edison Community College's Prekindergarten Associate License preparation program meets the Chancellor's requirements for program approval and the State Board of Education's minimum standards for associate level programs leading to the Prekindergarten Associate License. Approval is recommended for Edison Community College's associate level program leading to the Prekindergarten Associate License until the fall 2023 review cycle. It should be noted that the program is subject to periodic review by the Chancellor to ensure that the standards for Ohio licensure continue to be met.
