# COLLEGE CREDIT *Plus*

## AT EDISON STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

College Credit Plus (CCP) offers a unique opportunity for students to enhance and further their educational and career objectives while still in high school. The benefits of CCP include:

- Free to participate
- Earn high school and college credit concurrently
- Save time and money
- Complete college coursework within a familiar support system
- Transfer college credits seamlessly to four-year universities nationwide *or* apply credits towards industry-recognized degrees and certificates at Edison State

## GET *Started*

### SUBMIT A LETTER OF INTENT

Students must submit a Letter of Intent to their high school by **April 1st** (or dates established by the Chancellor of the Ohio Dept. of Higher Education). This letter informs the school district of the student's intent to participate in the CCP program for the following school year. Many schools have a custom Letter of Intent tailored to the district's needs. See your school counselor for more details.

### COMPLETE YOUR EDISON STATE ADMISSION



#### APPLY

Visit [www.edisonohio.edu/getstarted](http://www.edisonohio.edu/getstarted) to create an account and apply. Select the "College Credit Plus" option as your student type. After your application is submitted, you'll be able to upload the following items:

- CCP Parent/Guardian Permission Slip
- High School Transcript (Jr. High students may submit a copy of their most recent report card.)

Note: Your application is not complete until these items are uploaded.



#### QUALIFY

To participate in the CCP program, students must meet statewide program eligibility standards. The academic records submitted at the time of application will be evaluated to determine program and course eligibility. Edison State provides FREE ACCUPLACER testing for students needing additional assessment to establish program eligibility or improve course eligibility.

Edison State Community College offers three options for establishing CCP program eligibility.

##### OPTION 1: 3.0 GPA

Students with a cumulative, unweighted high school GPA of a 3.0 or higher.

##### OPTION 2: 2.75 GPA and Relevant High School Coursework

Students with a cumulative, unweighted high school GPA of 2.75 - 2.99 with a grade of "A" or "B" in at least ONE of the following high school courses:

- Algebra II equivalent
- English 10 or higher
- Geometry or higher
- Any AP Course
- Junior-level career technical course

##### OPTION 3: College-Ready Assessment Scores

Students that meet college-ready assessment scores in at least ONE area.

- ACCUPLACER: 250 Reading or 263 Math (QRAS or AAF portions)
- ACT: 18 English, 22 Reading, or 22 Math



#### REGISTER

Consult with your high school counselor or meet with an Edison State Enrollment Manager to select and register for courses. Courses are available online, on campus, and at select high schools. A CCP registration form is required for each semester of participation.



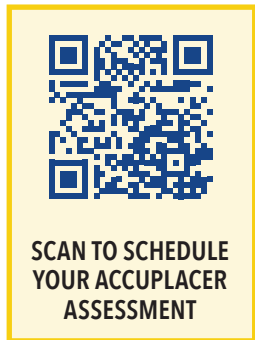

# ASSESSMENT *Guide*

## The Assessment Process... *How Do I Qualify?*

- A TRANSCRIPT REVIEW**  
The academic records submitted with your application will be evaluated to determine program and course eligibility. *Students who do not have a qualifying high school GPA should proceed to ACCUPLACER testing to establish eligibility.*
- B ACCUPLACER TESTING**  
Students can complete the ACCUPLACER assessment for FREE at any campus location, by appointment. Visit [www.edisonohio.edu/ccpqualify](http://www.edisonohio.edu/ccpqualify) or scan the QR code to schedule your ACCUPLACER appointment.



## Program Eligibility & Course Eligibility... *What's the Difference?*

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY	COURSE ELIGIBILITY
<p>Establishing program eligibility permits a student to participate in the CCP program. Program eligibility standards are set by the state. Program eligibility must be established before a student can determine what courses they are eligible to take.</p> <p><b>Establish CCP program eligibility one of three ways.</b></p> <p><b>OPTION 1: 3.0 GPA</b> Students with a cumulative, unweighted high school GPA of a 3.0 or higher.</p> <p><b>OPTION 2: 2.75 GPA &amp; Relevant High School Coursework</b> Students with a cumulative, unweighted high school GPA of 2.75 – 2.99 with a grade of “A” or “B” in at least ONE of the following high school courses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• English 10 or higher</li> <li>• Algebra II equivalent</li> <li>• Geometry or higher</li> <li>• Any AP course</li> <li>• Junior-level career technical course</li> </ul> <p><b>OPTION 3: College-Ready Assessment Scores</b> Students that meet college-ready assessment scores in at least ONE area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ACCUPLACER: 250 Reading or 263 Math (QRAS or AAF portions)</li> <li>• ACT: 18 English, 22 Reading, or 22 Math</li> </ul>	<p>Meeting course eligibility requirements, or course prerequisites, permits a student to enroll in specific college courses. Course eligibility requirements are set by Edison State.</p> <p><b>Students who are program eligible AND meet the criteria listed below qualify for these common Edison State course prerequisites.</b></p> <p><b>NO PREREQUISITES:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All students eligible for CCP qualify for courses without prerequisites.</li> </ul> <p><i>Course examples: ART 123, BUS 110, COM 121, FIN 116</i></p> <p><b>ENGLISH READY:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2.75 HS GPA and an A or B in English 10 or higher <b>OR</b> Qualifying reading assessment score             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ACT Reading 22+</li> <li>• ACCUPLACER 250+</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><i>Course examples: ENG 121, HST 121, PSY 121, SOC 121</i></p> <p><b>STATS/REASONING READY:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2.75 HS GPA and an A or B in Geometry or higher <b>OR</b> Qualifying math assessment score             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Algebra II equivalent</li> <li>• ACT Math 20+</li> <li>• ACCUPLACER QRAS 263+</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><i>Course examples: BIO 121, MTH 120, MTH 125</i></p> <p><b>MATH READY:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3.0 HS GPA and an A or B in Algebra II or higher <b>OR</b> Qualifying math assessment score             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ACT Math 22+</li> <li>• ACCUPLACER AAF 263+</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><i>Course examples: MTH 122, MTH 123, MTH 128</i></p>

Admission into the CCP program does not guarantee course eligibility. A full list of course descriptions and prerequisites can be viewed online through the academic catalog. Academic advising is available to assist students with eligibility information and course selection.

## APPLICATION *Deadlines*

Students must complete admission into the College Credit Plus program before Edison State’s semester start dates, which are listed below. Edison State will not accept applications after the start of the semester.

- Summer: June 2, 2025
- Fall: August 25, 2025
- Spring: January 19, 2026

For optimal course availability, it is strongly recommended that prospective CCP students complete the admission, assessment, and registration steps by the timeline outlined below:

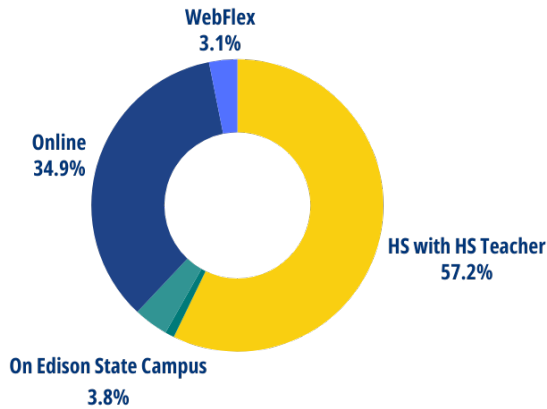
- Summer and Fall Registration–Complete admission before your high school’s summer break.
- Spring Registration–Complete admission before your high school’s winter break.

These guidelines apply to students taking classes online, on campus, or at their high school.

## COURSE MODALITY



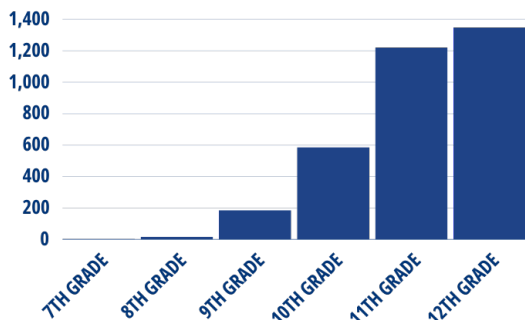
