# President's Report to the Edison State Community College Board of Trustees May 16, 2024

## > President's Office

- Edison State's 49<sup>th</sup> Commencement Ceremony on May 10 was a tremendous success! Nearly 250 graduates received their diplomas, and attendance by their family members and friends was strong. Thank you to Amber Hare, Heather Lanham, the Facilities Team, the Department of Public Safety, and everyone who did a wonderful job of planning and running ceremony! See the statistics below on the Class of 2024:
- **662** graduates earned **836** degrees and certificates.
- Ages range from 17.5 to 65. Median age is 26.220 (43%) are 21 or younger and 20 (3.03%) are 50 or older.
- **43** will graduate with honors (GPA 3.5-3.74), **33** with high honors (GPA 3.75-3.99), and **27** with highest honors (GPA 4.0).
- **64%** are female, **36%** male.
- **36%** live in Miami County, **17%** in Shelby County and **18%** in Darke County.
- **20** Ohio counties are represented.
- **51** graduates are high school seniors, **2** are high school juniors, and **1** is a high school sophomore.
- 18% of graduates completed at least one developmental course.
- **36%** transferred credit hours to Edison State.
- **184** students with transfer credit totaled **6,201** hours transferred, averaging **34** hours per student.
  - The Blue and Gold Gala on May 11 saw nearly 150 attendees, who enjoyed outstanding musical performances, a wonderful meal, and excellent décor. The event served as the culmination of Edison State's 50th anniversary celebration. # > Academic and Student Affairs

- The Child Development Center had its Step Up to Quality verification visit on April 24 and earned a continuation of its Five Star rating. Congratulations to Holly Short and the CDC staff on this accomplishment!
- With three weeks to go until the start of the summer semester, enrollment compared to summer of 2023 is up by 10% in headcount and 13% in credit hours.

- Edison State's "50 Next" Capital Campaign is off to wonderful start. We have presented our projects to numerous local foundations, the Miami County Commissioners, and state legislators. Currently, we have \$375,000 in donations from the following groups:
  - 1. \$250,000 from the Troy Foundation
  - 2. \$100,000 from the Piqua Foundation
  - 3. \$25,000 from the Tipp Foundation
- When you include state and federal grant funds, the total amount raised so far is approximately \$3 million.

• The Finance Department is nearing completion on the fiscal year 2025 budget. We will hold an All-College Budget Update Meeting on June 17 to give employees a preview of next year's budget, and the full budget will be presented to the Board of Trustees for approval on June 26.
